This 63-acre park commemorates major phases of American social, cultural, and economic history across three centuries through the occupancy of one family, the Ridgelys, as well as their large and diverse work force.

Since the mid-20<sup>th</sup> century, Hampton has represented a partnership between public and private support. Historic Hampton, Inc., a non-profit cooperative organization, assists the National Park Service in generating community awareness and in helping expand and enhance the historical, educational, and interpretive activities at Hampton National Historic Site.
